LandWatch Monterey County has tracked implementation of policies in the 2010 General Plan for the last 11 years. We have reviewed Exhibit -1 Summary 2021 Annual Report Matrix and compared it to our matrix that identifies policies categories requiring implementation (attachment). We are pleased to see some implementation progress. However, of the over 70 policy categories identified, 28 are under development, including the DES, and 43 have no schedule.

As noted in our prior annual comments, it is essential for the County to provide adequate resources to assure full implementation of the 2010 Monterey County General Plan.
