AB 1614 - The FORA Extension

State Assembly member Bill Monning has proposed an extension of the Ford Ord Reuse Authority (FORA) via Assembly Bill (AB) 1614, which would allow the Authority to unconditionally continue operating an additional 10 years. Currently FORA is set to sunset on June 30, 2014.

Your Talking Points

Request the bill get sent to the Assembly Appropriations Committee because the bill's implementation comes with a state-mandated cost. LandWatch opposes AB 1614, unless four issues are addressed:

1. An update of the Fort Ord Base Re-Use Plan
2. Phasing of land uses and infrastructure to address urban blighted areas first
3. Elimination of fees to appeal project approvals from local jurisdictions to the FORA Board
4. Improved enforcement of an Updated Fort Ord Base Re-Use Plan
